

Property Taxes

The municipality sends out two (2) bills every year:

Interim Property Tax bills are issued early in March and will be due and payable no later than March 31st.

Final Property Tax bills are issued late August, following the passing of the current year's budget and the calculation of tax rates and will be due and payable no later than September 15th.

The municipality charges interest, at a rate of 15% per year, on any outstanding amount of taxes that have not been paid. The interest is charged on the first day of default and then on the first day of each month following.

Payments

Payments may be made as per the following methods;

- In person at the Township of Dorion Municipal Office, by cash or cheque Regular Office Hours Monday, Tuesday and Thursday ~ 9:00 a.m. 4:30 p.m.
- By internet banking through a financial institution
- Post-dated cheques

Property owners are advised to allow 3-5 business days for the payment to reach the Township, if not paying in person. Any electronic payment, credit will be given on the day funds are received in the Township of Dorion's bank account.

Current Value Assessment (CVA)

The assessment used to calculate your property taxes is determined by the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC). MPAC classifies and assesses all properties under the *Assessment Act* and regulations established by the Provincial Government.
